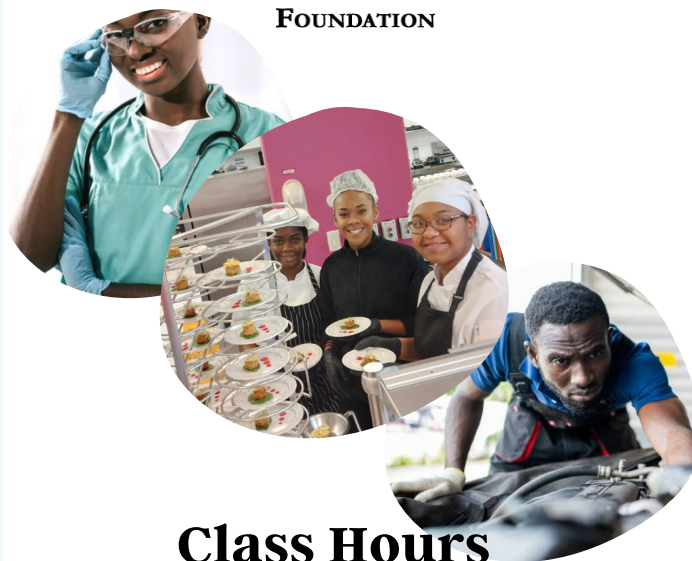
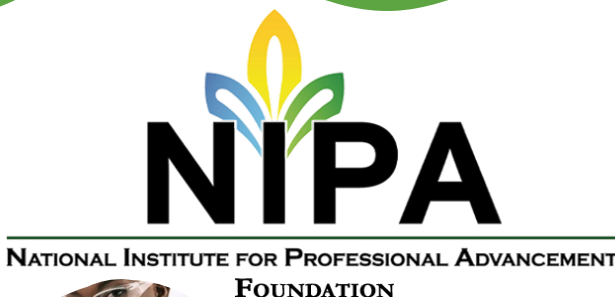

2. Copy of registration form or proof of appointment (from the census office)
3. Copy of St. Maarten ID or Passport
4. Two recent passport pictures
5. Diploma (with transcript), certificates or most recent report card
6. NON-REFUNDABLE registration fee(ANG. 50, or USD \$27.75)
