Admissions Checklist

1. APPLICATION

- Application:

Let us know which program you're interested in by heading to: https://admissions.monroecollege.edu/register/international_programs. We'll then send you an email providing you with login details to access the application portal.

- Essay:

The essay is your time to shine and communicate why you want to pursue a degree and how it will help you achieve your career goals.

(350 words for undergraduate applicants and 500 words for graduate applicants)

- Application Fee:

\$35 for undergraduate study or \$50 for graduate study.

2. TRANSCRIPT & DOCUMENTATION

- Transcript: You must upload your highschool transcript, diploma, or degree to the online application portal

- Resume and Recommendation Letters:

Persons applying for a Master's degree must submit their resume and 2 recommendation letters.

3. INTERVIEW

- Schedule your interview: Your interview with an advisor can be by phone, Zoom, and Skype. Once you submit your online application, an advisor will be connecting with you to set up an interview.

4. ADMISSIONS DECISION

- Decision: You will receive a decision from the Monroe Admissions Committee promptly via email once all checklist items have been submitted.
